


# All about....Pattern/Sequence

DID YOU KNOW?



## Did you know that...

- Pattern is all around us in our clothes, furniture, wallpaper, artwork etc.
- There are 3 types of pattern repeating, growing and symmetrical
- Learning about patterns help children learn about sequencing
- Pattern helps develop the ability to problem solve and improves concentration
- Develops the child's hand-eye co-ordination and control
- Develops the child's ability to listen for patterns in music
- To be confident in exploring pattern, children need to be able to copy, continue and create a pattern or sequence



### Things to do when out and about...

- Explore natures patterns while on your daily walk (trees, flowers, and the ground etc.)
- Create your own pattern using natural objects - flowers, sticks, stones etc.



# Things to do at home...

- Make your own pattern sequence using objects around the house, such as, socks, sweets, coloured pencils etc.
- Finish the pattern An adult can start a pattern sequence and ask the child if they can finish it.
- Threading pattern sequence using beads and spaghetti/thread.
- Building a tower using the same two or three colours, ask your child to continue the sequence (e.g. red, yellow, red, yellow)



 Table-top games using dice - can your child recognise the patterns on the dice? (subitising)
