Welcome Back- A warm welcome to you all. It is good to see you all back after the Summer break. I am delighted to say, so far, the children have settled back into their nursery. We are beginning to welcome new children and families to Penilee Nursery ③

Teaching and Learning- This month in Penilee staff will be supporting children to settle back into nursery, reforming relationships and revisiting nursery routines. Should you have any questions please call the nursery.

SeeSaw- Just a reminder that our main form of communicating with you is through seesaw. This will either be seesaw messages or seesaw posts. Please ensure you check regularly to keep up to date with your child's teaching and learning as well as information on events, adjustments and closures

Safe Parking- There has been an increasing number of families parking their cars on the Zig-Zag lines. This is illegal as well as extremely unsafe for the children and families who attend Penilee Nursery. I appreciate that parking outside the nursery is tight but the safety of children comes first.

Woodland Groups: We have welcomed 1 new temporary staff member to Team Penilee. Emma McCulloch will be the keyworker to the Rabbits whilst Dominique continues her maternity leave.

Things you need to know

Outdoor Play-As part of the Early Years Curriculum children access outdoor play daily in all weathers. This is for: Free play, participate in planned learning experiences as well as to complete their daily mile. To do this comfortably children have to have appropriate clothing. We do have a stock of wellies, snoods, all in one suits and fleeces but find that some children do prefer to wear their own clothes. With this in mind we ask that you ensure children are dressed appropriately for the weather and outdoor play whether this is in rain or sunshine. **Sun Safety-** Again as children access outdoor learning in all weathers and, at times, we can experience hot weather we ask that you ensure your children are protected appropriately. You can make your child sun safe by: *Applying sun screen to them before they come to nursery (For those children who access all day provision we will ensure their cream is topped up for the afternoon)

*We do have sun hats though if your child is particular about hats we ask that you bring in a sun hat to ensure it they are wearing one for protection.

*Covering little shoulders with t-shirts......children burn easily 🙁

*Ensuring shoes are suitable for outdoor play. Although sandals may be cooler there is a slip trip hazard as well as risk of little toes getting stood on when feet are not fully covered.

Can we ask that you ensure you put your child's name on all of their belongings, hats, shoes, jackets, cardigans and the like. This will ensure we have no mix ups of belongings due to children having the same items of clothing. **Personal Care-** As children may get wet due to taking part in water play or having a toileting accident you **must** ensure that you provide several changes of clothes (Tops, bottoms, pants and socks). Please ensure your child's spare clothes are replenished should we have to use some in nursery. This will save any inconvenience that may be caused by calling you to bring clothes to the nursery for your child.

Nursery Uniform - Order forms for uniforms are available from the office. Should you wish to order we ask that money is given in with the order form. An order will be placed at the end of September. Please note uniforms are not compulsory.

Nursery Fund - You may remember when you completed your child's enrolment paperwork that the Penilee Nursery Fund was mentioned. This fund is really important to the nursery to help buy special and everyday items for children to be safe, have fun, extend learning and receive treats.

The fund is £2 per week per child and can be paid weekly or monthly.....whatever suits you. These nursery funds are collected to purchase many items such as:

*Graduation gifts

*Christmas gifts

*Birthday gifts

*Easter eggs

*Goodies for parties and special celebrations

*Kindling for the fire pit

*Hot chocolate and snacks for cosy time round the fire pit

*Items to make playdough: Flour, oil, food colouring, essence

*Food tasting when celebrating occasions such as Chinese New Year, Burns Day, St Andrews Day, Diwali and Eid *As well as additional resources needed to provide daily planned learning experiences to promote teaching and learning.

Without your contribution we will be unable to provide all of these additional items and fun events that Glasgow City Council does not provide a cash budget for.

Please note Nursery Fund can be paid via bank transfer straight into the nursery account, sort code 832106 and account number 00149979. Should you choose to pay this way we ask that you put your child's full name along with NF as the reference. Payment can also be made in cash when you drop or collect your child at nursery. Just ask for an envelope and make sure that you put your child's name, the date and the amount you have placed in.

Children's Savings Club- Did you know we have a savings club for children to save their pocket money? The aim of this is to promote financial education as well as save a wee bit of money for a special something for a rainy day ③
