Personal Care: Even if your child is fully toilet trained they may have a toileting accident or get wet through play. Given this you must ensure that you bring a change of clothing for your child every day. We do not have appropriate spare clothing children to change them into.

Lost Property: We have a small coat stand with lost property and cannot match them to their rightful owners as there are no names on them. Please have a look when you are leaving nursery to see if you recognise any of the items and Please, please, please put your child's name on their belongings to ensure they are matched to the correct owner.

Nursery Resources: Unfortunately, lot of our small resources/toys are going missing. I appreciate that children sometimes take a shine to something and may really want to take it home but this results in children not being able to use things properly due to there being pieces missing. This also means we will have to buy the item again using up extra money (R) Given this I ask that if you happen to find any toys or objects that do not belong to your child can you please bring them back into nursery.

There will be a small tub left at the nursery entrance, under the bee chair, so that you do not even have to tell us that some of our toys have managed to get to your house ③ Thank you for your co-operation.



Nursery Fund: You may remember when you completed your child's enrolment paperwork that the Penilee Nursery Fund was mentioned. This fund is really important to the nursery to help buy both special, and everyday items, for children to be safe, have fun, extend learning and receive treats.

The fund is £2 per week per child and can be paid weekly or monthly......whatever suits you.

Unfortunately, we only have a small percentage of parents contributing to then nursery fund which means we will have to cut back when purchasing the items below:

- *Graduation gifts
- *Christmas gifts
- *Birthday gifts
- *Easter gifts
- * Sun Screen
- *Baby wipes

*Stickers for rewards and for occasions such as taking part in YOGA Bears, Lending Library and PAThS *Goodies for parties and special celebrations

- *Kindling/cotton wool/petroleum jelly for the fire pit
- *Hot chocolate and snacks for cosy time round the fire pit
- *Resources to make playdough- Flour, oil, salt and colouring
- *Resources for messy play-Shaving foam, cornflour for gloop.

*Fresh citrus fruit and herbs for the children to experience real items in the home area as well as to stimulate children's senses with the fresh smells

*Food tasting when celebrating occasions such as Chinese New Year, Burns Day, St Andrews Day, Diwali and Eid *As well as additional resources needed to provide daily planned learning experiences to promote teaching and learning.

* At times we may have to purchase larger items to aid outdoor play for example gazebos and outdoor clothing such as waterproofs, wellies and sun hats...or items to enhance the environment to make it cosy and homely for all children for example plants, rugs, cushions and lighting.

Without your contribution we will be unable to provide all of these additional items and fun events that Glasgow City Council does not provide a cash budget for.
