Example of the Goals children are learning about and how it is being promoted:

Global Goal-6 Clean Water and Sanitation – What is pollution and how it can affect water and animals. Global Goal-3 Good Health and Wellbeing- How we keep healthy through making healthy choices with food and exercise

Global Goal-15 Life on Land- Caring for the environment and the living things in it through picking up rubbish, feeding wildlife.

Global Goal-2 Zero Hunger- Beginning to learn the importance of not wasting food or water/milk

Global Goal-9 Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure- Discussing and trying out what materials would make good buildings through block play and construction toys as well as working together to build these.

Over the next few weeks, as we get closer to Christmas, we will focus on our Christmas celebrations and have a fun week beginning the 18th December for all to take part in.

Children will be learning about the true meaning of Christmas as well as taking part in Christmas themed learning experiences to promote Literacy, Numeracy, Health and Wellbeing as well as sharing, turn taking and being kind to our friends.

Sharing Important Information-We are using Seesaw messages and posts as a way of sharing all information with you. We ask that you check messages regularly to ensure you are kept up to date with what is happening in nursery as there may be important information that we need to pass on immediately.

A wee reminder...Please

Can I ask that you ensure you put your child's name on all of their belongings, hats, shoes, jackets, cardigans and the like. This will ensure we have no mix ups of belongings due to children having the same items of clothing.

Personal Care- ALL CHILDREN MUST BRING A CHANGE OF CLOTHES TO NURSERY.

As children may get wet due to taking part in water play, which is an integral part of teaching and learning, or having a toileting accident you must ensure that you provide several changes of clothes (Tops, bottoms, pants and socks). Please ensure your child's spare clothes are replenished should we have to use some in nursery. This will save any inconvenience that may be caused by calling you to bring clothes to the nursery for your child. Even if your child is toilet trained they may still need spare clothes for emergencies.

Should your child require their nappy to be freshened we ask you provide nappies, wipes and nappy sacs that we will store in their own little box.
