**Teaching and Learning:** Last term staff observed children closely to see what their interests were. This information will be used this term to ensure children are offered provocations to engage them in learning experiences that will be based round what they want to do. These are the interests we will be basing learning experiences round:

Personal Care: As children may get wet due to taking part in water play or having a toileting accident you must ensure that you provide several changes of clothes (Tops, bottoms, pants and socks). Please check your child's bag daily to make sure they have enough clothes as well as to ensure wet clothes are collected from the changing area. This will save any inconvenience that may be caused by calling you to bring clothes to the nursery for your child. Thank you for your co-operation.
